# 14/88B Minutes of the Environment and Planning Committee Meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2014

It was unanimously **resolved** to approve the minutes after a Proposal by Cllr McDonald and Seconded by Cllr Bigwood.

#### 14/89B Matters to Report

- 14/89.1B (Item 14/75.1B) <u>Pedestrian Routes</u> It was **resolved** to note that Cllr McDonald had met with Alex Johnstone and was awaiting a reply.
- 14/89.2B (Item 14/75.2B) State of Road at St Peter's Close It was **resolved** to note replies had been received from No. 4 Allard House and Magna Housing both stating they were not the owners of the land between the walls. After further investigation, by Cllr Peeks, it was suggested that County Council might be the owners. It was **resolved** the Clerk would contact Property Services to investigate further.
- 14/89.3B (Item 14/75.4B) <u>Village Information Board</u> No further information was available and Cllr McDonald was still researching the matter.
- 14/89.4B (Item 14/75.5 B) State of Market Ground & the Hole in Bank Street Despite several letters it was **resolved** to note still no reply had been received from Mr Gliddon. It was **resolved** the Clerk would write to Mr Gliddon again to request a site meeting.
- (Item 14/75.6B) Flooding Matters It was **resolved** to note the full report taken to the January Full Council meeting. Cllr McDonald reported still waiting for Highways to clear the stream from the Paddocks to the first bend along Doniford Road. The Clerk reported she has been informed by Highways that although they will clear the stream on this occasion it is not their responsibility, but that of the landowner, believed to be Wyndham Estate. Cllr Koch reported that the power line between Catwell and Townsend was catching floating debris, it was **resolved** that Cllr McDonald would investigate.
- 14/89.6B (Item 14/75.7) Owl Boxes in village The Clerk reported that Edward Martin would be willing to have the boxes erected on his land, on the condition that only Lew Newman would have access to the boxes, unless prior notification is given and agreed with Mr Martin. It was reported that Wyndham Estate would also be willing to have the boxes on their land, but require further information regarding access. After a proposition by Cllr Koch, seconded by Cllr Bigwood it was unanimously **resolved** that Lew Newman would liaise with both parties. Cllr Koch reported that the Parish has one free box; further boxes cost £75.00 each.
- 14/89.7B (Item 14/80B) <u>Doniford Footpath</u> It was **resolved** to note a letter had been received from Sarah Littler, together with a plan. After a discussion regarding ownership of the land, It was **resolved** to request a larger scale map 1:500 from Sarah Littler. A letter had been sent to Edward Down and it was **resolved** to wait until a reply had been received and then to physically measure the land to finalise land ownership. Cllr Peeks voiced concern that this was primarily for the benefit of the Railway as it would be a 'dead-end path'. After a proposition from Cllr Woods, seconded by Cllr Peeks, it was unanimously **resolved** that once replies had been received from Edward Down confirming his agreement and from Sarah Littler with a more detailed plan, a working party would be formed to mark out the exact path. The working party would include Cllrs Koch, Peeks and Woods in conjunction with Edward Down and West Somerset Railway.

14/89.8B (Item 14/81B) <u>Williton Market</u> It was reported that initial contact had been made with Watchet Town Council and Minehead Farmers Market and it was **resolved** to ask for further information, which may lead to asking a representative to attend a future meeting.

#### 14/90B Correspondence

- 14/90.1B It was **resolved** to note the proposed SID installation dates.
- 14/90.2B A letter had been received from West Somerset Council asking if the Parish Council could store sandbags. Although the Parish Council did not have a suitable storage area, it was **resolved** the clerk would contact Magna and Croft House to ask if they would be able to offer assistance.

#### 14/91B Highway Matters

- 14/91.1B It was **resolved** to note the reply from Gary Warren. It was **resolved** to report to highways the parking signs outside the Co-op and along North Road needed covering as it was causing confusion the parking restrictions need to be made clear.
- 14/91.2B It was **resolved** to note the communication from the Environment Agency. No comment made.

### 14/92B Finance and Budget

#### 14/93B Items to Report from Grounds Maintenance Officers

- Bridge Green (The Copse) A quotation had been received from Wibble Farm Nurseries for the replacement of a Betula pendula supply of tree only £29.50, to supply and plant £58.89. It was **resolved** to check if planting of the tree would be covered by Council contract. After a proposal from Cllr Bigwood, seconded by Cllr McDonald it was unanimously **resolved** if there was no contract, to instruct Wibble Farm Nurseries to supply and plant the tree and if a contract is in place for Wibble Farm Nurseries to supply the tree only. It was **resolved** to note that Cllr Bigwood and Cllr McDonald had placed more stones around the copse to stop the vehicles driving over the grass and causing erosion.
- 14/93.2B <u>Bellamy's Corner</u> It was reported roadwork signs were restricting access to Bellamy's Corner and needed moving to the right. It was **resolved** the clerk would liaise with Andrew Goodchild to confirm who to contact to ask for the sign to be moved.
- 14/93.3B Doniford Car Park It was **resolved** to continue with regular checks.
- 14/93.4B Recreation ground and Play Area It was **resolved** to contact County Council contractors to ask for the hedge by the children's' play area to be cut down to the height of the fence.

Concern was raised for the safety of Children speeding down the hill on their bikes and the possibility of them going straight onto the road. After a proposition from Cllr McDonald, seconded by Cllr Koch it was **resolved** to contact highways to ask if anything could be done.

#### 14/98B Village Gate

Village Gates, white fencing, that are erected by the village sign to give the impression that the road narrows which then encourages a reduction in speed. It was **resolved** that Cllr Koch would investigate the cost and whether highways would agree to the scheme.

It was **resolved** that Cllr Stiven would liaise with Love Williton regarding a date to clean Union Lane and report back to the next meeting.

### 14/100B Parking outside Sir Gilbert Scott Court

A discussion took place regarding the obstruction caused by cars parking outside the property on the main A39 and the safely implications. After a proposal from Cllr Koch, seconded by Cllr Peeks, is was **resolved** the clerk would contact highways and discuss the possibility of double yellow lines.
