12/79.3B It was **resolved** to note the Green Routine 2013 – campaign on waste action.

12/79.4B It was resolved to put forward the Committee's agreed responses to the Parish and Town Council Survey to the Finance and Administration Committee for their input.

12/79.5B It was **resolved** to note the details of funding available for Neighbourhood Plans.

12/79.6B It was resolved to note the Preferred Options Consultation of the Somerset Minerals Plan and to request a hard copy in order to comment. Cllr Peeks agreed to look at the document before passing on to Cllr Koch.

## 12/80B Highways Matters

- 12/80.1B Parking at Bridge Street It was **resolved** to note the concerns received from the resident of 6 Bridge Street and to reply advising him the Council had no intention of recommending removal of the one way system, but only looked at ways to improve parking. Cllr Wood proposed replacing the hatched lines on the corner with a pavement and therefore enabling the yellow lines just beyond to be removed making way for a further car space. It was **resolved** to agree to this proposal and the Clerk was asked to write to the Highways enclosing copies of the photographs showing the area.
- 12/80.2B <u>Pedestrian Crossing at Long Street</u> It was **resolved** to note the comments received from a resident and the correspondence and plans received from the County Council.
- 12/80.3B Barrier outside Fish and Chip Shop As Cllr McDonald was not at the meeting this matter was deferred.
- 12/80.4B Street name plate at Long Street Cllr Koch advised that the sign for Station Road had been put up at the wrong location and the Clerk was asked to write to the District Council requesting they meet on site with Cllr Koch to discuss the best location.

## 12/81B Finance and Budget Considerations

Two letters had been received from residents of Robert Street expressing concern that the proposed hogging at the entrance to the Recreation Ground could cause flooding problems. It was **resolved** to contact the builders to put the work on hold whilst advice was sought from professionals.

## 12/82B Items of Report from Grounds Maintenance Officers

- 12/82.1B <u>Bridge Green (The Copse)</u> It was **resolved** to note that the lease had been returned awaiting final copy.
- 12/82.2B <u>Bellamy's Corner</u> It was **resolved** to note that the plaque had been received. A response had been received from the surveyors of National Westminster Bank who perceived that the wall was part of the bank's landlord's property and would refer the matter to them.
- 12/82.3B <u>Doniford Car Park</u> It was **resolved** to note that the amended lease had been returned and would be passed to the Finance and Administration Committee for checking and signing. It was commented that the Groundsman had carried out good repairs to the car park.
- 12/82.4B Recreation Ground It was **resolved** to note that the dog fouling had improved but signs were needed to show the location of the litter bins. This matter was being dealt with by the Trustee of the Memorial Ground.

It was **resolved** to appoint an officer to look at the street furniture around the village and Cllr Woods agreed to take on this responsibility. Cllr Troman reported damage to the seat at Tower Hill and the Groundman would be asked to make the repairs if possible.
