12/125B Matters to Report

12/125.1B (Item 12/109.1B) <u>Safe Route to Schools</u> It was **resolved** to note the response from Watchet Town Council and to write back asking them if they would be willing to contribute towards the costs as it was felt that it would benefit their parishioners who shop or come to Williton
