Subject: Disabled Parking

I have been asked if parking for the Disabled could be provided outside of Gliddons in Williton. This was provided in the past but has been removed.

I pointed out that if you are disabled you can park on the side of the road in Williton but because the road is usually fully parked it has become difficult for those that are disabled to find a space. If the spaces that were at the side of Gliddons (some time ago) could be reinstated it would help. If you are disabled the slope in Killett Way Williton makes it difficult for those with a disability to use the public car park.
