Please could there be an Agenda item on Full Council concerning the above.

My reason for asking is as a lot of the remains of maize leaves are found on the road, pavements and people's drives following the transportation of the leaves to Cannington. The loads aren't covered and it is a nuisance when the debris also flies into your face. The debris not only looks unsightly but if not removed will decompose which weeds can grow in. The bits could also enter the drains and the bits may cause cars to skid if the driver brakes hard.

I have attached a few photos. These were taken a few days after the maize leaves were transported through the village so quite a lot has dispersed up side roads, into gardens and along the roads. I will send a separate email with some additional photographs as I can't send them all on one email.
